4.	Federal and State Properties: All of our Federal and State properties are fully accessible and inclusive to all people.					
5.	Websites: all of our byways related websites are accessible for those with visual disabilities. Websites meet W3C guidelines (http://www.w3.org/) and pass web checker tests such as: http://wave.webaim.org/ .					
6.	Transportation: If there is any transportation needed for visitors to participate in the byways experience, it is all accessible (boats, ferries, shuttles, etc.)					
7.	Scenic Areas: All of our scenic areas are fully accessible and inclusive. Information including interpretive and marketing information is provided in a variety of formats.					
8.	Cultural Areas: All of our cultural areas are fully accessible and inclusive. Information including interpretive and marketing information is provided in a variety of formats.					
9.	Archeological Areas: All of our archeological areas are fully accessible and inclusive. Information including interpretive and marketing information is provided in a variety of formats.					
10.	Recreational Areas: All of our recreational areas are fully accessible and inclusive. Information including interpretive and marketing information is provided in a variety of formats.
